



Do I qualify for Dual Enrollment?

- Rising junior or senior in high school
- GPA of 3.0 in core courses on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum combined SAT Verbal and Math score of 970 OR ACT composite score of 20
- Minimum separate SAT Verbal 480 and Math 440 OR ACT English 20 and Math 18

How do I apply for Dual Enrollment with Georgia Perimeter College?

- **Complete a Georgia Perimeter College application online:** [APPLY NOW](#)
- **Pay the \$20 application fee.** A credit card is required to pay online.
- **Submit an official high school transcript.** See if your high school can electronically upload the transcript to gacollege411.org.
- **Submit a current Certificate of Immunization.**
- **Submit a Parental Consent Form.**
- **Have an official SAT or ACT score report sent** directly to GPC from College Board. The college code for the SAT is 5711 and the college code for the ACT is 0806. The location will be Clarkston, GA.
- Students wishing to exempt and receive credit for ENGL 1101 must have their AP scores sent directly to GPC. Other AP scores should also be sent to GPC. The college code for AP scores is 5711. The location will be Clarkston, GA.

What happens after I apply?

- You will receive a letter with your GPC ID number. This number is used instead of your social security number to track your records.
- You can check the status of your application online at www.gpc.edu/mystatus.
- Your acceptance letter will be sent from the Admissions office on the Clarkston campus.
- Before you can register for classes, you must complete an online orientation for Dual Enrollment students at www.gpc.edu/~dunje.
- You will register for classes with the Dual Enrollment Coordinator.

What courses can I take?

- Dual Enrollment students can take any college course; however, ACCEL funding for residents of Georgia will only pay tuition for courses in the five core areas of Social Science, Science, English, Foreign Language, and Mathematics including Philosophy and Economics courses.
- If you want to enroll in a math class above MATH 1111, College Algebra, you will be required to take a placement test on one of the GPC campuses. AP scores can also be used for math placement.
- If you want to continue your foreign language study, placement is determined by the foreign language department.
- As a Dual Enrollment student, you are eligible to take courses on any GPC campus.
- In selected cases, Dual Enrollment students can take online courses as well. Online courses may require students to come to campus for tests.
